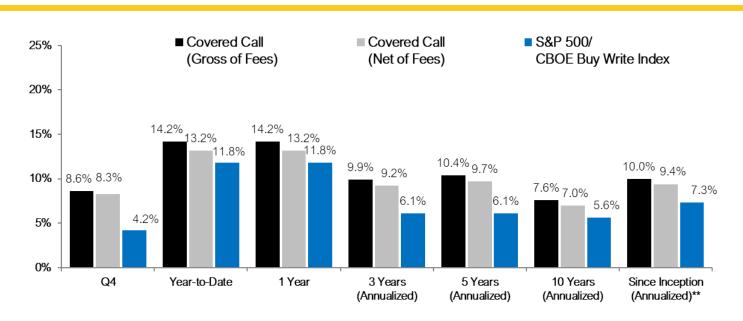

OBJECTIVES

- Invests for long-term total return with enhanced income and reduced volatility.
- Seeks to invest in conservatively financed, large-capitalization, dividend paying stocks at reasonable prices. Writes covered calls against each position on 50% to 100% of the shares in the stock portfolio.

ADVANTAGES

- <u>Actively Managed Options Writing</u> Helps you avoid downward volatility (or skew) and capture greater upside of a company's performance.
- <u>Separately Managed Account</u> Enables single stock options writing which allows the portfolio manager to be more opportunistic and gives the investor greater flexibility with the percent of the portfolio that has options written against it.
- <u>Two Income Streams</u> Target dividend income above the S&P 500 market yield while adding income premium from writing options against the individual companies in the portfolio.

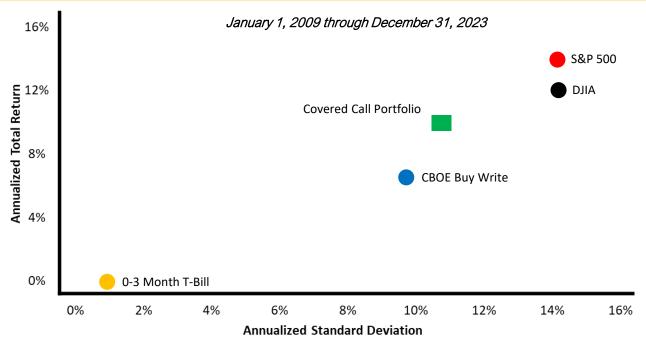
